
Understanding Singapore in the Past and Present

# SWIRL


'SWIRL' is a mnemonic for the five main areas of language learning: **S**peaking & Representing, **W**riting & Representing, **I**ntegration & Immersion in learning Grammar & Vocabulary, **R**eading & Viewing, an **L**istening & Viewing.

'SWIRL' conceptualises the processes of T & L of English Language (EL) in Xingnan.

In today's VUCA world, students must learn beyond communicating in EL but be effective and affective communicators of EL.

'SWIRL' serves as Xingnan's blueprint to support the achievement of the objectives of all EL programmes and initiatives that perpetuate the development of the three competencies in our pupils: **empathetic communicators**, **discerning readers and creative inquirers**.

'SWIRL' facilitates the creation of a vibrant learning environment where students use EL language as an opportunity and platform to create values, discover new knowledge and learn new skills.

### **Integration & Immersion**


Find ways to get your child to use EL in his/ her daily life e.g. seeking assistance from a sales assistant at a mall.

### Writing

Allow them to purposefully express their emotions in print taking into consideration the purpose, audience, context, and culture.

#### **S**peaking

Provide opportunity for them to speak in proper and standard EL.



### Reading

Provide varied and ageappropriate EL reading materials at home for children's use from diverse print, non-print and digital networked sources.

#### Listening

Get them to listen to others' views and perspectives before making any judgments.

## (1) WHOLE – Listening, Reading and Viewing
