7 Habits of Highly Effective People






A Self-directed Learner, A Gracious Citizen

Leaders Lead Leaders Programme

- Develop staff and pupils to be highly effective people
- To have a common 'language' in habits across curricular and non-curricular departments / subjects
- Experience a coherent and specific spiral approach from developing personal effectiveness to interpersonal effectiveness
- To be preventive and proactive rather than being reactive





Integration of the 7 Habits into

- Lessons

 Core team working with CCE Team of teachers, to include the teaching of the 7 habits into the FTGP, creating an opportunity for the intentional learning of the habits.
- >School programme, including curricular subjects would also have the 7 habits languages included in their lessons.



How can parents play a part?

- For a start, understand what the 7 habits mean.
- You can also have conversation with your child about their learning from school.
- Check with them how they have practice the language.
- Refer to the pupils' diary. At the end of every week, there is a reflection portion as well as their plan to sharpen their saw for the weekend.
- As pupils hear the languages on a regular basis, they would be able to understand it better and soon apply it as part of their lives.

Discipline Matters

- Seek to work closely and actively with all parents to develop good characters of their children.
- Collaboration and co-operation between school and home for effective discipline
- Do contact your child's/ ward's form teacher for any discipline matters
- To make use of the pupils' handbook for ease of communication

- Anxiety

Sense of Responsibility

- Do encourage your child/ ward to pack their school bag the night before
- Do guide your children to check their school bags and teach them the responsibility of packing their bags daily
- Teach them to be independent and responsible for their own belongings



Learning Dispositions

- To shift away from assessing students on academic results only to assessing students holistically based on key learning dispositions that the teachers observe
- To allow young students to have a more positive start to their education, focusing on discovery, joy of learning and holistic development
- To provide milestone checkpoints on the students' learning at certain year in a primary school





School-based awards – Model Pupil Award

- At the end of every term, students who have demonstrated exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions in school will be awarded the "Model Pupil Award" (MPA).
- This is also to motivate and inspire others as these model pupils will be role models on how exemplary Xingnanian should behave.
- These learning dispositions and school values will be used as criteria to select the nominees of MPA.



MOE-Based awards

- The learning dispositions will also be used as criteria to select the nominees of the following Edusave awards:
- a) Edusave Merit Bursary (EMB)
- b) Good Progress Award (GPA)
- c) Edusave Character Award (ECHA)
