SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS FOR EDUSAVE CHARACTER AWARD (ECHA)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The award is given out to **Singaporean students** who have met the selection criteria and who have cleared the selection process. All Singaporean students are eligible for the award **regardless of the level that they are in.**
2. The nomination process is open to all students, staff, parents
3. Students may be nominated regardless of their academic results provided that their weak academic results are not due to negative behaviours but are attributed to difficulties that go beyond the control of the student.
4. The nominated student must have demonstrated **good character and values** in a **consistent manner.** Students may be identified for the following types of qualities:
 - (a) Qualities associated with **school values (Respect, Responsibility, Loyalty, Empathy or Creativity):** Students should have been nominated for the **Model Pupil Award at least once in the current year;** and/or
 - (b) Demonstrated a high level of **civic responsibility:** Students must have demonstrated concerns about issues related to their community or issues faced by others. They could have initiated simple action and played an active role to address these issues and demonstrate commitment to making a difference; and/or
 - (c) Qualities associated with **resilience:** Students who have persevered despite facing difficult circumstances (e.g. financial problems, health issues, family issues, peer resistance etc) and have managed to overcome the odds.
